Mayor Pro Tem Smith established a quorum, called the meeting to order, welcomed those in attendance and the following items of business were conducted:

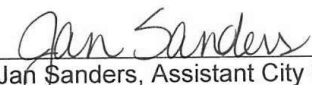
ITEM 1:
