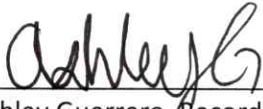
1. **Rose Garden Update:** Mr. Kashuba reported that the Rose Garden beds have been completely cleared and will be redesigned, installed, with the future possibility of being maintained by the Randall County Master Gardeners, with \$10,000 in funding provided by a private donor. The project aims to create a well-maintained, showcase garden for the community. Due to concerns about rose rosette disease, options for future rose plantings are being evaluated, including retaining roses in select areas while developing surrounding demonstration gardens.
2. **Art Pad Discussion:** Mrs. Perez reported that the art pads have been relocated to Sam Houston Park and El Alamo Park. Signage is pending approval and plans are underway for a ribbon-cutting ceremony. She also noted that outreach efforts at the Juneteenth celebration will encourage local artists to display artwork and participate in showcasing their artwork on the structure.
